

Positioning Yourself for Supernatural Increase

DAY:

Monday

TITLE:

You Are a Covenant Person

KEY VERSE:

Psalm 115:12 -- "The Lord has been mindful of us. He will bless us; He will bless the house of Israel; He will bless the house of Aaron."

REFLECTION:

I want you to hear this straight from my heart -- God has not forgotten you. He is mindful of you. That means He knows your name, your address, and every detail of your life. When I preached on Psalm 115, I kept coming back to this stunning truth: you are a covenant person. If you love Jesus, you have a binding agreement with Almighty God, and that agreement is to bless you and increase you. We spend so much time rehearsing last year's failures, defeats, and frustrations. But I want you to shut that down today. This is a new slate. God doesn't look at your yesterday and cancel your blessing. He looks at the blood of Jesus and says, "This one is mine, and I will increase them." Receive that today. Let it settle deep in your heart -- you are valued, remembered, and chosen for increase.

PRAYER:

Father, thank You that You know my name and You haven't forgotten me. Help me to truly believe today that I am Your covenant child and that increase is already Your plan for my life. I receive it in Jesus' name, amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Write the words "I am a covenant person" on a sticky note and place it somewhere you will see it throughout the day -- your mirror, your dashboard, or your desk.

DAY:

Tuesday

TITLE:

Believe It Before You See It

KEY VERSE:

Romans 8:32 -- "He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?"

REFLECTION:

I love this verse because it settles the argument before it even starts. If God gave us Jesus -- His most precious gift, His own Son -- why would He hold anything else back from us? Everything else is minor by comparison. When I studied this while putting together our devotional book on increase, I got so pumped I could barely sit still. The logic of Romans 8:32 is airtight: the greater gift has already been given. That means healing, provision, purpose, restored relationships -- all of it -- is available to you. But here is the key step I shared on Sunday: you have to believe in your heart that God wants to increase you. Not just mentally agree

with it, but really believe it down deep. Don't let last year's disappointments write the story for 2026. God is the maximizer. He wants to take your life and grow it. Say it out loud right now -- I believe God wants to increase me.

PRAYER:

Lord, I choose to believe today that You hold nothing good back from me. Thank You for the gift of Jesus, and thank You that everything else flows from that. Grow my faith to match Your generosity, in Jesus' name, amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Speak Romans 8:32 aloud three times today -- once in the morning, once at lunch, and once before bed. Let your own voice declare God's generosity over your life.

DAY:

Wednesday

TITLE:

Get Close -- The Distance Has to Go

KEY VERSE:

Joshua 1:8 -- "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success."

REFLECTION:

My grandmother gave me a Bible when I was about eight years old, growing up in Swaziland. Inside the cover she wrote, "The keys to success -- Joshua 1:8." I never forgot it. The Word of God is the foundation of everything. I shared on Sunday that a study of over a thousand churches found the single greatest factor in a believer's spiritual growth is reading and reflecting on scripture daily. That is not a coincidence -- that is God's design. You cannot get close to God from a distance, and distance closes when you open your Bible. I am challenging myself right along with you. If you want supernatural increase this year, you cannot afford to keep the Word at arm's length. Read it. Meditate on it. Let it get so deep inside you that when the enemy comes with a lie, the Word rises up and shuts him down immediately.

PRAYER:

Father, give me a genuine hunger for Your Word today. Help me to carve out time to read, reflect, and listen. I don't want to follow You from a distance -- I want to be close, in Jesus' name, amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Choose a Bible reading plan today -- whether through the YouVersion app, our church plan, or a simple chapter-a-day approach -- and commit to it in writing. Tell one person about your commitment to keep yourself accountable.

DAY:

Thursday

TITLE:

Rise Up -- Stop Tolerating the Enemy's Lies

KEY VERSE:

Psalm 115:9 -- "O Israel, trust in the Lord; He is their help and their shield."

REFLECTION:

I told the congregation on Sunday something I feel deeply -- we have a real enemy, and he is working overtime to stop the plan of God for your life. He wants your business small, your marriage struggling, and your faith shaken. But here is what I need you to understand: his primary weapon is deception. If he cannot deceive you, he cannot steal from you. He lies about your situation, your worth, and your future. The Word of God is the antidote to every single one of those lies. I think about my mentor Norval Hayes grabbing those doorposts in a heart attack and refusing to accept it, saying, "Not to me you don't, devil." That is the spirit I want you to walk in today. You are not helpless. You have a shield -- the Lord Himself. Trust Him, stand behind that shield, and speak back to every lie with the truth of God's Word.

PRAYER:

Lord, I trust You as my help and my shield today. I refuse to tolerate what the enemy is saying about my life, my family, and my future. I stand on Your Word and declare that no weapon formed against me will prosper, in Jesus' name, amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Identify one lie you have been agreeing with -- about yourself, your finances, your health, or your relationships -- and write down one scripture that directly contradicts it. Speak that scripture aloud as a declaration before you go to sleep tonight.

DAY:

Friday

TITLE:

Become a Sower -- Everything Is a Seed

KEY VERSE:

Psalm 115:14-15 -- "May the Lord give you increase more and more, you and your children. May you be blessed by the Lord, who made heaven and earth."

REFLECTION:

I want to close our week with this truth that stirred my heart so deeply in sermon preparation: everything in your life is a seed. Your time is a seed. Your words are a seed. Your acts of kindness are a seed. Your financial giving is a seed. God gave Adam the power of the seed in Genesis, and He has given it to you too. The Philips translation of Galatians 6:7 says it perfectly -- "A man's harvest in life depends entirely on what he sows." That means the increase you are believing for in 2026 is connected to what you are sowing right now. I think about Vicki, who drove hours to Bible school, sowed time and sacrifice into the Word, and watched her entire life shift -- her worship, her marriage, their finances. Supernatural increase did not fall from the sky. It grew from seeds faithfully sown. Start sowing intentionally today, and trust God for the harvest.

PRAYER:

Father, help me to become a faithful, joyful sower in every area of my life. I trust that what I sow in faith today, You will multiply for Your glory and my increase. I am positioning myself for everything You have for me in

2026, in Jesus' name, amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Sow one intentional seed today -- encourage someone with a specific word of life, give generously to a need you encounter, or invest an extra fifteen minutes in prayer. Do it on purpose, believing God sees every seed you plant.
