

The Laws for Supernatural Increase

DAY:

Monday

TITLE:

God Is the Source of Every Good Thing

KEY VERSE:

Psalm 35:27 -- "Let them shout for joy and be glad, who favor my righteous cause; and let them say continually, 'Let the Lord be magnified, who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.'"

REFLECTION:

I want you to hear this truth deep in your spirit today: God is not holding back from you. He delights in your prosperity. I have watched people spend years believing that struggle is somehow more spiritual than increase, and I want to break that lie off you right now. God commanded the manna to fall. He commanded the water from the rock. He commanded the blessing over Isaac in the middle of a famine. He is still the same God today. The key is keeping your eyes fixed on Him as the source. When things begin to increase in your life, the temptation will come to pat yourself on the back and say, I did this. Do not fall for it. Every promotion, every open door, every provision has His fingerprints on it. He is the blesser. Stay close to Him and watch what He does.

PRAYER:

Father, I confess that I sometimes forget You are the source of everything good in my life. Forgive me for taking credit where only You deserve the glory. I trust You today to be my provider and my blesser in Jesus' name.

DAILY ACTION:

Write down three specific blessings in your life and next to each one, write the words "God did this."

DAY:

Tuesday

TITLE:

You Cannot Grow in God Without Growing in His Word

KEY VERSE:

Mark 4:14 -- "The sower sows the word."

REFLECTION:

I have been walking with God for a long time now, and I will tell you honestly that the more I learn, the more I realize how vast He is. That humility only comes from time spent in His word. You cannot grow in God outside of Scripture. I know that sounds simple, even elementary, but I have watched people skip this step for years and then wonder why their faith feels weak and their lives feel stuck. A quick snack of the word once a week will not build the spiritual muscle you need for supernatural increase. I think about Susanna Wesley, mother of John Wesley, with all those children and all those cloth diapers, carving out one hour every single day to be alone with God. She found the time because she knew what was at stake. You can find the time

too. Make a decision today that the word of God will have a place in your daily life.

PRAYER:

Lord, make me genuinely hungry for Your word. Help me guard my time and make space every day to sit with You and let Scripture take root in my heart. I want to grow in You, not just in knowledge but in real, lasting faith.

DAILY ACTION:

Choose a Bible reading plan today and read the first assigned passage, even if it is only a few verses, before you go to bed tonight.

DAY:

Wednesday

TITLE:

Keep Sowing Even When You Are in a Famine

KEY VERSE:

Deuteronomy 8:17 -- "Then you say in your heart, 'My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth.'"

REFLECTION:

When I came out of my business broken and hurting, I had every reason to sit down and feel sorry for myself. People had done me wrong. My confidence was shaken. But I felt God say something that changed everything: sow. So I sowed my time every Saturday in the poorest neighborhood I could find, going soul winning, pouring myself out when I had nothing left to pour. That is exactly what Isaac did. He sowed in a famine land with no water and no guarantee, and in that same year he reaped a hundredfold return. That was not Isaac's cleverness. That was God commanding the blessing on a seed sown in an impossible season. The worst thing you can do when things get tight is stop giving, stop serving, stop showing up. That is exactly when the enemy wants you to retreat. Do not let him win. Keep sowing in Jesus' name.

PRAYER:

Father, I admit that when life gets hard I am tempted to pull back and protect what little I have. Give me the courage to keep sowing even in my dry seasons, trusting that You will command the blessing on every seed I plant in faith.

DAILY ACTION:

Do one act of intentional generosity today, whether it is your time, a kind word, or a financial gift, and do it specifically because things feel tight, not in spite of it.

DAY:

Thursday

TITLE:

You Are Blessed to Be a Blessing

KEY VERSE:

Genesis 12:2 -- "I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing."

REFLECTION:

God told Abram something I never want you to miss. He said I will bless you, yes, but then He said and you shall be a blessing. That second part is just as important as the first. God does not increase you so you can build a bigger fence around what you have. He increases you so you can reach further into the lives of people who are hurting. I have seen this principle work in my own life and in the lives of people I have walked with for years. When your heart turns from accumulating to distributing, something supernatural shifts. God can trust you with more because you are not hoarding it. You become a pipeline, not a reservoir. I think about the single mothers who need a car just to get to work, just to hold their lives together. Your increase was meant to meet needs like that. Ask God today how He wants to use what He has given you.

PRAYER:

Lord, I receive Your blessing with an open hand, not a closed fist. Show me today who I can pour into and how I can be a channel of Your goodness to someone who is struggling. Let my increase always be connected to Your purposes.

DAILY ACTION:

Identify one person in your life who has a practical need and make a plan this week to meet it, even in a small way.

DAY:

Friday

TITLE:

Your Destiny Is in Your Hands -- Start Sowing It Today

KEY VERSE:

2 Corinthians 9:10 -- "Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness."

REFLECTION:

I want to close this week by looking you in the eye and saying something I mean from the bottom of my heart: your destiny is in your hands. I know that sounds bold, but hear me out. God has already decided He wants to increase you. He has already set the law in motion. The seed is available, the power is available, the command of blessing is available. But you have to sow. You have to show up. You have to open your Bible, guard your mouth, serve somebody, give something, and refuse to let last year's limitations define 2026. I am not satisfied with staying where I was, and I do not want you to be either. A lifestyle of sowing is not something you try once and evaluate. It becomes who you are. When you live that way, consistently, faithfully, even in the hard seasons, God multiplies what you sow and the supernatural becomes your normal. That is what I am believing for you in Jesus' name.

PRAYER:

Father, I make a fresh commitment today to be a sower. I am done with small thinking and I am reaching for everything You have planned for my life. Multiply every seed I plant and let Your supernatural increase be the story of my life this year.

DAILY ACTION:

Write down one area of your life where you have stopped sowing and make a specific commitment about how you will start again this week.
