

The Covenant That Cannot Be Broken

DAY:

Monday

TITLE:

You Have a Covenant Right

KEY VERSE:

Exodus 15:26 -- "I am the LORD who heals you."

REFLECTION:

I want you to hear something straight from my heart this morning -- before God called Himself your provider, your banner, or your shield, the very first redemptive name He revealed was Jehovah Rapha: the God who heals you. That wasn't an accident. God knew that sickness would shut down everything you're called to do for Him. He knew we'd face disease, pain, and fear. And so before anything else, He said, I am your healer. This isn't a maybe. It's not a sometimes. It's a covenant right -- ratified in blood, sealed for eternity. When I was fighting a deadly disease myself, I had to get this deep in my spirit. Not just in my head, but in my heart. You are a covenant person with Almighty God. That means healing belongs to you. Start believing it today like your life depends on it -- because honestly, it might.

PRAYER:

Lord, You are my Jehovah Rapha -- the God who heals me. I receive that truth into my spirit right now and I thank You that healing is my covenant right. Help me to stop treating it like a maybe and start standing on it like the guarantee it is. Amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Speak Exodus 15:26 out loud three times today, replacing "you" with "me" -- "I am the LORD who heals me" -- and let it settle deep in your spirit.

DAY:

Tuesday

TITLE:

The Blood Cannot Be Broken

KEY VERSE:

Galatians 3:13 -- "Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us, for it is written, 'Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree.'"

REFLECTION:

I need you to get this down in your spirit today -- a covenant sealed in blood cannot be broken. When I think about what God did through Jesus on that cross, it overwhelms me. Sickness is a curse. Poverty is a curse. Death is a curse. And Jesus literally became that curse so you and I would never have to carry it. That's not religion -- that's a blood covenant more powerful than anything the devil can throw at you. I've stood in that place where the battle was real and the enemy was pressing hard. And I came back to this one truth: the blood of Jesus has already paid the full price. Every sickness, every bondage, every fear -- the price is paid.

You don't have to earn your healing. You just have to believe the blood is enough. Because it is. It absolutely is.

PRAYER:

Jesus, thank You for becoming a curse so I could walk in blessing. I stand today on the covenant You sealed with Your own blood and I declare that sickness, lack, and bondage have no right to stay in my life. Your blood is enough. Amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Write Galatians 3:13 on a sticky note and place it somewhere you'll see it throughout the day -- your mirror, your desk, your kitchen counter -- as a reminder that the curse has been broken over your life.

DAY:

Wednesday

TITLE:

Let the Word Do Its Work

KEY VERSE:

Romans 4:17 -- "God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did."

REFLECTION:

Here's something I've learned the hard way -- your head can know the Word without your heart ever receiving it. That's the gap where so many people get stuck. I've watched people sit under teaching, nod along, and walk away unchanged because they treated it like new information instead of living truth. But when you water your spirit with the Word -- when you keep coming back to it, speaking it out, dwelling on it -- something shifts inside you. Abraham didn't start out calling things that be not as though they were. He got there. He developed it. And that's what I want for you this week. Don't rush past the Word because you've heard it before. Let it go deeper. Let it get louder in your spirit than the symptoms, the fear, or the doubt. The Word is working in you even when you can't feel it.

PRAYER:

Lord, I ask You to make Your Word come alive in my heart today, not just my head. Water my spirit with truth and let my faith rise higher than my circumstances. I choose to speak what You say about me, not what I see. Amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Find one healing scripture -- perhaps Psalm 107:20 or Isaiah 53:5 -- and read it slowly out loud twice today, pausing to let each word land in your heart before moving on.

DAY:

Thursday

TITLE:

Everything on the Altar

KEY VERSE:

Romans 4:17 -- "God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did."

REFLECTION:

I think about Abraham on that mountain with Isaac, and what moves me most is this -- Abraham put everything on the altar. His son, his promise, his future. And because he did, God found a covenant-keeping man. And here's what I want you to hear today: that act opened the door for God to send His own Son. Abraham's obedience set a precedent in the spirit that echoed all the way to Calvary. Now, I'm not saying God is asking you to sacrifice your child. But He is asking -- are you all in? Because a covenant is a two-way street. God gave everything to you, and He wants everything from you. Your life, your will, your dedication. When I fought for my health and fought the federal government for seven years, I had to get to a place of total surrender. And I found that when I gave God everything, He covered everything. That's how covenant works.

PRAYER:

Father, I put everything on the altar today -- my fears, my plans, my health, my future. I trust that You are a covenant-keeping God and that what I surrender to You, You will cover with Your faithfulness. I'm all in for You. Amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Take five quiet minutes today to write down one thing you've been holding back from God -- a worry, a plan, a fear -- and consciously hand it to Him in prayer, saying, "Lord, this is Yours."

DAY:

Friday

TITLE:

Remember the Covenant at the Table

KEY VERSE:

Exodus 15:26 -- "I am the LORD who heals you."

REFLECTION:

Every time we take communion together, we're doing something profound in the spirit -- we're ratifying the covenant. We're saying out loud, with our bodies and our faith: I believe the blood is real. I believe the covenant holds. I believe healing belongs to me. That's not just a church ritual. That's a declaration that echoes through eternity. I want you to close this week by remembering what you've been delivered from. You were bound, you were in darkness, you were heading the wrong direction -- and God reached down and pulled you out. Not because you earned it, but because of covenant love. So today, as you reflect on what Christ did at that table with His disciples -- when He said, this cup is the new covenant in my blood shed for you -- receive it fresh. Let gratitude rise. Let faith rise. This covenant is everlasting. It cannot be broken. And it is yours.

PRAYER:

Lord Jesus, I remember Your covenant today with a grateful heart. I receive the healing, forgiveness, and blessing that Your blood has already purchased for me. Thank You that this covenant is everlasting and that I am Yours. Amen.

DAILY ACTION:

If you have bread and juice at home, take a moment of personal communion today. As you do, speak these words: "I am a covenant person with Almighty God. His healing belongs to me. The blood of Jesus is my guarantee."
