

# Take Dominion

**DAY:**

Monday

**TITLE:**

You Have Authority -- Use It

**KEY VERSE:**

James 4:7 -- "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you."

**REFLECTION:**

I want you to understand something this week -- you are not a victim. When I talk about taking dominion, I'm not talking about arrogance or pride. I'm talking about knowing who you are in Christ Jesus. The Bible says resist the devil and he will flee. That word resist in the Greek means to stand against, to oppose, to push back. That means when fear knocks on your door, you don't open it. When oppression tries to settle on your shoulders, you shake it off. When darkness creeps into your home, you command it to leave in the name of Jesus. You have been given authority through the blood of Jesus Christ. God doesn't want you hiding behind a rock, peeking at the battlefield. He wants you in the fight, standing tall, fully dressed in His armor, knowing that you and God together are a majority in every situation.

**PRAYER:**

Father, today I choose to submit myself fully to You and stand against everything the enemy is throwing at me. Thank You that because Jesus lives in me, I am never outnumbered. In Jesus' name, amen.

**DAILY ACTION:**

Write down one area where fear or oppression has been speaking to you, then speak out loud over it: "In Jesus' name, I resist you and you have no authority here."

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**DAY:**

**TITLE:**

Speak It Before You See It

**KEY VERSE:**

1 Samuel 17:45 -- "David said to the Philistine, 'You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the Lord Almighty.'"

**REFLECTION:**

Young David stood before a nine-foot giant with nothing but a sling, some stones, and the name of the Lord. But here's what I love -- he didn't wait to see the outcome before he opened his mouth. He declared the victory before the stone ever left his hand. He told Goliath he was going to cut his head off, and David didn't even have a sword yet. That is the kind of faith God is calling out of you and me right now. You've got to speak where you're going before you get there. Declare that you are clothed in the armor of God. Declare that the Holy Ghost is working in you. Declare that God's Word is alive in your situation. Your words carry weight in the spirit realm, and when you open your mouth in faith, mountains begin to move.

**PRAYER:**

Lord, give me the bold faith of David today -- to open my mouth and declare Your victory before I ever see it with my eyes. I speak Your Word over my life, my family, and my future right now. In Jesus' name, amen.

**DAILY ACTION:**

Stand in front of a mirror this morning and speak one declaration of faith out loud over your life -- about your health, your finances, your family, or your peace.

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**DAY:**

Wednesday

**TITLE:**

Shake It Off and Keep Moving

**KEY VERSE:**

Acts 28:5 -- "But Paul shook the snake off into the fire and suffered no ill effects."

**REFLECTION:**

I love the Apostle Paul. A venomous snake latched onto his hand, and do you know what he did? He shook it off. He didn't panic. He didn't sit down and write a letter about how terrible his day was going. He shook it off and kept moving. That is exactly the attitude God wants in each of us. The enemy is always going to try to attach something to you -- fear, discouragement, sickness, offense, oppression. And sometimes it grabs hold before you even realize it. But the moment you recognize it, you shake it off in the name of Jesus. You don't nurse it. You don't rehearse it. You don't carry it around for weeks. You shake off the fear. You shake off the sadness. You shake off whatever is dragging you down, because the Spirit of God in you is greater than anything the enemy throws at you.

**PRAYER:**

Holy Spirit, help me today to identify anything that has attached itself to my life that doesn't belong there, and give me the courage to shake it loose in Jesus' name. I refuse to carry what You already paid for me to be free from. Amen.

**DAILY ACTION:**

Identify one negative thought pattern or emotion that has been clinging to you this week, and physically shake your hands as a symbolic, prayerful act of releasing it to God right now.

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**DAY:**

Thursday

**TITLE:**

Your Home Is a Castle

**KEY VERSE:**

Joshua 24:15 -- "But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord."

**REFLECTION:**

When I pull into my driveway, I know what lives in that house -- the peace of God. When I walk through that

front door, I don't bring chaos in with me. I don't allow fear to set up furniture in my living room. I've declared it, I've prayed over it, and I've taken dominion over it in Jesus' name. And friend, I want you to do the same thing. Your home is not just a building -- it is your territory. God gave it to you, and you have every right to command peace to reign there. Command unity to reign there. Command the presence of God to fill every room. Run the devil out of your marriage, out of your children's bedrooms, out of your finances. He has no legal right there when Jesus is Lord of your house. Stand in your field. Don't give an inch.

**PRAYER:**

Father, I declare right now that my home belongs to You, and I take dominion over every assignment the enemy has against my family. Let Your peace, Your presence, and Your power fill every corner of where I live. In Jesus' name, amen.

**DAILY ACTION:**

Walk through every room of your home today and quietly pray a simple blessing over each space, declaring peace and the presence of God in that room.

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**DAY:**

Friday

**TITLE:**

You Are Not Backing Down

**KEY VERSE:**

Ephesians 6:13 -- "Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand."

**REFLECTION:**

After everything -- after the week has pushed back, after the enemy has thrown his worst, after the circumstances looked impossible -- after all of that, the Word of God says you are still standing. That is the promise I want to leave you with as you close out this week. You don't have to win every argument. You don't have to have every answer. You just have to keep standing. The Church of Jesus Christ is not a defeated, hiding, frightened people. We are the triumphant ones -- because the One who lives inside of us has already won. I want you to go into your weekend with your head up and your shoulders back. You've got the Word of God in your heart, the Spirit of God in your belly, and the name of Jesus on your lips. You are not backing down. Not now. Not ever.

**PRAYER:**

Lord, thank You that because of Jesus, I am still standing at the end of this week. I put on Your full armor right now and I choose to walk into the weekend as more than a conqueror through Christ who loves me. Amen.

**DAILY ACTION:**

Text or call one person in your life today and encourage them with these words: "You are not backing down -- God is with you and you are going to make it."
