

The Divine Blessing On The Tithe

DAY:

Monday

TITLE:

Whose Money Is It Really?

KEY VERSE:

Leviticus 27:30 -- "And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the tree, is the Lord's. It is holy to the Lord."

REFLECTION:

I want to be honest with you about something that changed my life -- the moment I stopped calling my money mine. When I really sat with Leviticus 27:30, I realised the tithe was never mine to begin with. God isn't asking for a favour when He asks for the first ten percent. He's simply asking you to return what already belongs to Him. Think about it -- you didn't create yourself, your talents, or the opportunities that put money in your hands. Every good thing flows from Him. When I understood that returning the tithe wasn't a transaction but an act of honour, everything shifted. It stopped being about law and started being about love. Positioning yourself under God's blessing begins with this simple acknowledgement: He is the owner, and I am the steward.

PRAYER:

Father, I confess I've sometimes treated my money as fully mine. Help me see everything I have as a gift from Your generous hand. I want to honour You as the true owner of it all.

DAILY ACTION:

Write down your monthly income and calculate exactly what ten percent looks like -- not to guilt yourself, but simply to see clearly what honouring God first would mean for you practically.

DAY:

Tuesday

TITLE:

Positioned For The Blessing

KEY VERSE:

Malachi 3:10 -- "Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this, says the Lord of hosts, if I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it."

REFLECTION:

I love this verse because God does something He almost never does anywhere else in Scripture -- He actually invites you to test Him. That word please sits quietly in the original Hebrew right beside that command. Please. God is essentially saying, I have a blessing with your name on it, and I'm begging you not to block it. I've watched this happen in my own life and in the lives of people in my congregation year after year. When you get yourself into position -- when you put God genuinely first with your finances -- you move

into the target zone of heaven's open windows. It isn't about perfectly understanding how it all works. I honestly can't fully explain how God does it. But I've seen it too many times to doubt it. Faith doesn't always need an explanation. It just needs your obedience.

PRAYER:

Lord, I want to position myself under Your open windows. I choose to trust Your Word even when my natural mind pushes back. Pour out Your blessing as You promised -- I'm stepping into position today.

DAILY ACTION:

Read Malachi 3:10 slowly three times today -- once in the morning, once at lunch, and once before bed. Let it move from your head down into your heart.

DAY:

Wednesday

TITLE:

The First Tithe And The Greater Blessing

KEY VERSE:

Genesis 14:19-20 -- "Blessed be Abram of God Most High, possessor of heaven and earth; and blessed be God Most High, who has delivered your enemies into your hand. And he gave him a tithe of all."

REFLECTION:

Abraham didn't wait until the law of Moses to tithe. He gave a tenth to Melchizedek -- the priest of the Most High God, a beautiful picture of Jesus -- because something in his spirit understood that honouring God with the first portion was the right response to a supernatural victory. The greater always blesses the lesser, and Melchizedek blessed Abraham. That same dynamic is alive today. When we bring our tithe to God through our local church, we're placing ourselves under the blessing of the One who is greater -- Jesus Himself, our eternal high priest. I've seen this principle work in my family, in businesses, in marriages. It's not complicated theology. It's covenant living. Abraham's blessing was passed to us through Christ. We are the seed of Abraham. That divine empowerment -- that supernatural momentum -- it belongs to you too.

PRAYER:

Father, thank You that I am Abraham's seed and an heir to Your covenant blessing. I don't want to live beneath what You've already provided. I honour You today as God Most High, possessor of everything.

DAILY ACTION:

Look up Galatians 3:29 and write it on a sticky note. Place it somewhere visible today as a reminder that you are an heir to Abraham's blessing.

DAY:

Thursday

TITLE:

Breaking The Power Of The Curse

KEY VERSE:

Galatians 3:13 -- "Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, 'Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree')."

REFLECTION:

Someone once pushed back on me and said, "Pastor Mirek, I can't be under any curse -- Jesus became a curse for me." And I said, you're absolutely right. But let me ask you something. Jesus also paid the price for your healing -- yet do we sometimes still fight sickness? Of course we do. Being legally free from something doesn't mean we automatically walk in that freedom without faith and obedience. The curse of lack, financial struggle, and the devourer having access to your resources -- Jesus purchased your freedom from all of that. But you have to take authority. You have to actively align your life with God's Word. Tithing isn't earning your blessing. It's enforcing what Christ already won for you. It's saying, devil, you have no access here. I'm walking in covenant. I'm free, and I intend to live like it.

PRAYER:

Jesus, thank You for redeeming me from every curse. I receive the full freedom You purchased for me -- in my body, my mind, and my finances. Help me walk in that freedom boldly and consistently.

DAILY ACTION:

Take two minutes today to speak Galatians 3:13 out loud over your finances specifically. Declare that the curse of lack has no authority over your life because of what Jesus did.

DAY:

Friday

TITLE:

Only What's Given Can Be Blessed

KEY VERSE:

Matthew 14:19 -- "And He commanded the multitudes to sit down on the grass. And He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitudes."

REFLECTION:

I love this moment in the Gospels so much. Five loaves, two fish -- completely insufficient by any natural calculation. But watch the sequence: Jesus took it, He blessed it, He broke it, and He gave it. The multiplication didn't happen while the boy was still holding his lunch. It happened after it was released. This is one of the most important financial principles I've ever preached on, and I mean it from my own life -- only what is given can be blessed. When you hold everything tightly, you leave God nothing to multiply. But the moment you open your hand, look out. I've watched God take what looked small and insufficient and turn it into something nobody could explain except to say, that was God. That's the divine blessing. Release it. Trust Him. Watch what He does.

PRAYER:

Lord, I open my hands today. I don't want to hold so tightly to what I have that I miss what You want to multiply. Bless what I give and do what only You can do with it.

DAILY ACTION:

Find one practical way to give generously today -- whether that's your tithe, an offering, or meeting a practical

need for someone around you. Take the step and release it with joy.
