

The Scriptures Cannot Be Broken

DAY:

Monday

TITLE:

The Word That Cannot Be Broken

KEY VERSE:

John 10:35 -- "If he called them gods, to whom the word of God came -- and the Scripture cannot be broken..."

REFLECTION:

I want to start this week by anchoring your heart in something that never moves -- the Word of God. I've stood in moments where everything around me was shaking, and the one thing that held me was this Book. When I was fighting for my life, I clung to Psalm 107:20 -- "He sent his word and healed them." Not sometimes. Not maybe. He sent His word. That word went out like a missile and it hit its target. The Scripture cannot be broken -- not by your circumstances, not by your doubts, not by the culture around you. God's Word isn't a suggestion. It's a declaration from the God who made the universe. What He says, stands. Forever. This week, I want us to build our confidence back up in this Book. Let it be the foundation under your feet again.

PRAYER:

Father, forgive me for the times I've treated Your Word casually. This week, I choose to receive it with fresh eyes and an open heart. Let it go deep in me, in Jesus' name. Amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Pick up your Bible today and read Psalm 107:20 three times out loud, slowly. Let each word land in your heart.

DAY:

Tuesday

TITLE:

The Word Is God -- Take It Seriously

KEY VERSE:

John 1:1 -- "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."

REFLECTION:

I want you to understand something that changed everything for me -- you cannot separate Jesus from the Word. They are one. When I look at John 1:1, I see that God didn't just send a message, He became the message. Jesus is the living Word of God walking among us. So here's what that means for you and me practically -- your relationship with the Word of God is your relationship with Jesus. You don't love Jesus more than you love His Word. You don't honor God more than you honor what He's said. I'm not saying this to condemn you -- I'm saying it to wake something up inside you. Every time you open this Book, you're sitting down with Jesus Himself. Every time you push it aside, you're pushing Him aside. Let that sink in

quietly today.

PRAYER:

Jesus, I want to know You more deeply. Teach me to see Your face every time I open the Word. Let my love for You grow through loving what You've said. Amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Before any screen time today -- phone, TV, computer -- spend five minutes reading from the Gospel of John. Just five minutes. Put Jesus first.

DAY:

Wednesday

TITLE:

His Word Sends Healing

KEY VERSE:

Psalm 107:20 -- "He sent his word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions."

REFLECTION:

This verse was a lifeline for me personally, and I want it to become one for you too. Notice what God did -- He sent His word. He didn't send a feeling. He didn't send a programme. He sent His Word, and that Word carried the power to heal and deliver. I believe with everything in me that there is no situation in your life too broken for this Word to reach. Sickness? He sent His Word. Broken marriage? He sent His Word. Depression, fear, confusion? He sent His Word. The problem is we sometimes treat the Word like advice rather than medicine. You wouldn't take half a dose of medicine and expect full results. Get the Word in you -- all of it, not just the comfortable parts. Let God's healing word go to work in every area where destruction has tried to settle in your life.

PRAYER:

Father, I receive Your Word today as medicine for my soul and strength for my body. Send Your Word into every broken place in my life and let it do what only You can do. Amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Write Psalm 107:20 on a sticky note and place it somewhere you'll see it repeatedly today -- your mirror, your desk, your kitchen counter. Each time you see it, say it aloud.

DAY:

Thursday

TITLE:

Love God, Keep His Word

KEY VERSE:

John 14:21 -- "He who has my commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him."

REFLECTION:

Jesus made it beautifully simple, didn't He? You want to see Me? Keep My Word. I've watched this play out in my own life over many years of walking with God. The closer I've stayed to what He's asked me to do, the more real He's become to me. Not distant. Not theoretical. Present. Manifesting Himself -- that's Jesus' own language. He shows up in tangible, undeniable ways to those who take His Word seriously and walk it out. It's not about perfection -- we all stumble. But it is about direction. Are you moving toward the Word or away from it? Are you letting it shape your decisions, your relationships, your responses? The measure of your love for God will show up in how you treat what He's said. That's not condemnation -- that's an invitation to go deeper with Him.

PRAYER:

Lord Jesus, I want to love You with more than words. Show me one area today where I can walk out Your Word more faithfully. I want You to manifest Yourself in my life. Amen.

DAILY ACTION:

Ask yourself honestly today: "Is there a command from God's Word I've been avoiding?" Name it. Then take one small step toward obedience in that area before the day ends.

DAY:

Friday

TITLE:

Awe for the Word That Stands Forever

KEY VERSE:

Psalm 119:161 -- "My heart stands in awe of your word."

REFLECTION:

I love David. He was a warrior, a king, a flawed human being -- and yet he looked at the Word of God and his heart stood in awe. That's where I want us to finish this week. We've talked about the power of the Word, the authority of the Word, the healing in the Word, and the love shown through the Word. Now I want to ask you -- do you stand in awe of it? Not familiarity. Not casual Christianity where we pick the bits we like. Genuine, holy awe. Heaven and earth will pass away before a single jot or tittle of God's Word fails. Dynasties have risen and crumbled. Every person who ever lifted a finger against this Book is gone. And the Book is still here. Still true. Still working. Still saving. Still healing. Let your heart stand in awe again this Friday. The Word of God cannot be broken -- and it is for you.

PRAYER:

Father, restore a holy awe in my heart for Your Word this day. Let me never take it for granted again. Thank You that Your Word stands forever, and it stands for me. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAILY ACTION:

End your week by finding a quiet place, holding your Bible in your hands, and simply thanking God for giving you His Word. Then read one Psalm aloud as an act of worship.
